

## RECORD OF PROCEEDING

Minutes of Burton Township Trustees  
Held at the Burton Township Administration Building

Regular Meeting  
May 23, 2016

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**Jim Dvorak, Chairman, opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m. with Board members: Ken Burnett and Dan Whiting in attendance. Those present joined the Board in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.**

**Terri McIntee introduced herself. She is running for the Ohio House – District 76.**

**Ken Zwolinski, Trustee from Troy Township, was present to talk about the roads shared with Burton Township. The two townships share Shedd Road with Middlefield and Parkman Townships. There are no issues with the road. Middlefield and Parkman have been plowing the road in the winter.**

**Public Comment: Mrs. Adamic was present to express her disgust in the condition of Old Rider Road. She is not pleased with the amount of dust on the road and the manner that the road is plowed in the winter. Mr. Luoma commented that Colony Road is in the best condition that he has ever seen it.**

**Minutes: The regular meeting minutes from May 9, 2016 were approved by a motion from Mr. Whiting and seconded by Mr. Burnett. Vote: Mr. Dvorak – yes, Mr. Burnett – yes and Mr. Whiting – yes.**

**Cemetery: Diann Finzel and Martha Evvs will meet with Chris Carroll on June 3<sup>rd</sup> at Slitor Cemetery.**

**Roads: The Slitor Cemetery sign was picked up and put in. The old pillars were taken down. Multiple roads were side mowed. Trash Day went well. The ruts were repaired at the fairgrounds. A chipper was rented to clean up brush on Durkee, Station, and Memorial. A piece of chain-link fence was put by the pipe on Pond Road to control the beaver dam. Mulch was put down in the cemeteries and around the administration building. The park signs were repainted and the grills were repaired. Joanne George received a phone call from Herb Shubick of the Geauga County Health Department. The Department has received grant monies to pay for the pickup of tires and trash in the County to stop the spread of mosquitoes and viruses.**

**Fiscal Officer: Mr. Whiting made a motion to request the advancement of the second half real estate taxes. Mr. Burnett seconded this motion. Vote: Mr. Dvorak – yes, Mr. Burnett – yes and Mr. Whiting – yes. There was discussion about putting a new fire levy on the November ballot. Mr. Burnett will talk to the BCPA about getting the three entities, Burton Township, Burton Village and Claridon Township, together to talk about the fire contracts and levies.**

**New Business: None.**

**Old Business: Mr. Dvorak is still collecting quotes for the replacement of the roofs on the Township Administration Building and Pavilion. Mr. Burnett received a letter from David Lair concerning the ODOT facility. Burtontownship.org is now LIVE!!**
