

RECORD OF PROCEEDING

Minutes of Burton Township Trustees
Held at the Burton Township Administration Building

Regular Meeting
November 21, 2016

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Jim Dvorak, Chairman, opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m. with Board member: Dan Whiting in attendance. Those present joined the Board in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: The regular meeting minutes from November 7, 2016 tabled until all Trustees are present.

Cemetery: Gingerich Excavating submitted the 2017 pricing. This matter was tabled until the next meeting.

Public Comment: None.

Roads: The snow fence was put up. The trucks were undercoated. Gravel was put down on Colony and Durkee Roads. Ronyak Bros, Inc. completed the full depth repairs on Mosswoods, Burton Heights Blvd. and Hubbard. Repair work was completed at the Akron barn. A letter of request was received from the Burton Township residents of Colony Lane. The residents would like the road barricaded at the Village of Burton / Burton Township line for the safety of transit on Colony Lane. Mr. Dvorak attended the Burton Village meeting and talked to Mayor Koster about Garden Street/Colony Lane. Mr. Dvorak met with the County Engineer about Bigelow Road. The Engineer would like a resolution to mark unused roads as non-maintained status and then another resolution to vacate the road.

New Business: The Trustees received notification that Ms. Jessica Nelson has filed a Notice of Appeal against the Burton Township Zoning Inspector, the Burton Township Board of Trustees and the Burton Township Board of Zoning Appeals for the action taken by the Burton Township Board of Zoning Appeals on September 15, 2016 denying the request of Jessica Nelson for a use variance on the property located at 14219 Claridon-Troy Road in Burton Township on the grounds that such action was unconstitutional, illegal, arbitrary, unreasonable and unsupported by the preponderance of substantial, reliable and probative evidence on the whole record.

Fiscal Officer: Mr. Whiting made Resolution 2016-12 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor. Mr. Dvorak seconded this resolution. Vote: Mr. Dvorak – yes and Mr. Whiting – yes.

The next regular meeting will be Monday, December 5, 2016 at 7:30 pm.

Warrants: Warrants #9355 thru #9368 were approved and paid.

As there was no further business, this meeting was adjourned at 8:24 p.m. by a motion from Mr. Dvorak and seconded by Mr. Whiting. The vote was unanimous.
