

RECORD OF PROCEEDING

Minutes of Burton Township Trustees
Held at the Burton Township Administration Building

Regular Meeting
July 3, 2017

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Ken Burnett, Chairman, opened the meeting at 7:38 p.m. with Board members: Dan Whiting and Jim Dvorak in attendance. Those present joined the Board in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: The regular meeting minutes from June 18, 2017 were approved with a motion from Mr. Whiting and seconded by Mr. Dvorak. Vote: Mr. Burnett – yes, Mr. Whiting – yes and Mr. Dvorak – yes.

Public Comment – Mr. Ed Hale was present and praised the road department for the well maintained roads and the condition of the cemeteries.

Zoning: The Zoning Board of Appeals held a conditional use hearing for Mr. Scott Hoar. The hearing will be continued in August.

Cemetery: Mrs. O'Neill presented two cemetery plot deeds to be signed by the Trustees. They were for a lot transfer from Sandy Burzanko to Bob Burzanko in 1W3, Seciton 1 – Old West in Slitor Cemetery and a transfer from Bob Burzanko to Sandy Burzanko in 1W4 – Old West in Slitor Cemetery.

Roads: White and Hotchkiss Roads were cold patched. Truck maintenance was completed. The Buckeye Trail was mowed. The grader was taken down on Hale and Durkee Roads. The berms were cut down and graded. Mulch was put down at the administration building and the pine trees were trimmed.

Fire Department: No one in attendance.

Fiscal Officer: Mrs. Katie O'Neill was bonded as the cemetery sexton. Mr. Burnett read Mrs. O'Neill her oath.

Old Business: Mr. Mike Miller will make the necessary repairs to the pavilion as a result of the Illuminating Company's truck backing up into it. The Township will pay Mr. Miller and seek reimbursement from the Illuminating Company.

New Business: Mr. Whiting would like a five-year budget from the Burton Volunteer Fire Department for the next meeting.

The next regular meeting will be July 17, 2017 at 7:30 pm.

Warrants: Warrants #9635 thru #9655 were approved and paid.

As there was no further business, this meeting was adjourned at 8:52 p.m. by a motion from Mr. Whiting and seconded by Mr. Dvorak. The vote was unanimous.
