

## RECORD OF PROCEEDING

Minutes of Burton Township Trustees  
Held at the Burton Township Administration Building

Regular Meeting  
April 1, 2019

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**Ken Burnett, Chairman, opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m. with Board members: Dan Whiting and Jarred Miller in attendance. Those present joined the Board in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.**

**Minutes: The regular meeting minutes from March 18, 2019 were approved as corrected with a motion from Mr. Miller and seconded by Mr. Burnett. Vote: Mr. Burnett – yes, Mr. Whiting – abstain and Mr. Miller – yes.**

**Public Comment: Mr. Nick Gorris from the Geauga County Engineer's Office was present to update the Trustees on the status of Hotchkiss Road. The plans are 95% complete. Mr. Dan Demko told the Trustees that Mr. Jim Gillette is Hillside's legal counsel. Mr. Rob Demko inquired about the status of Station Road.**

**Cemetery: The veterans would like a service plaque on the back of a headstone. There was a discussion on how to install it. There is a Zoning Commission meeting on April 9, 2019 and the continuation of the Walsh/Bohm Zoning Board of Appeals meeting is on April 18, 2019.**

**Fire Department: No one in attendance.**

**Park Committee: Mr. Jerry Davis met with Terry Murphy and they walked the part of the Buckeye Trail that is in Burton Township. Mr. Murphy would like to replace the footbridge by Memorial Cemetery at no cost to the Township. Mr. Miller will talk with the Geauga Park District.**

**Roads: Trees were cut down and ditching was done on Durkee. Trees were also cut down on Hotchkiss and Burton Heights. The salt spreader was sprayed with fluid film. A tree quote for work on Hotchkiss Road was received from Roubic Tree Service. The Trustees would like a second quote.**

**Zoning: Two permits was issued. They were for a granted variance and a commercial addition. Mr. Gary Kaufmann submitted an application for a sewage lagoon. The setback is incorrect on the solar panels on Jug Road. There was an inquiry about a sober house. Mr. Andrew Miller applied for a single family dwelling in March 2014. The Trustees would like a signed affidavit stating that he will make the barn that he is currently living in into a 100% agricultural barn.**

**Fiscal Officer: A check for \$3,644.08 was received from the Amish Road fund. The R-3 was approved by the Ohio Historical Society.**

**Old Business: Station and Chipmunk Roads were discussed.**

**New Business: None.**

**The next regular meeting will be April 15, 2019 at 7:30 pm.**

**Warrants: Warrants #10329 thru #10344 were approved and paid.**

**As there was no further business, this meeting was adjourned at 9:52 p.m. by a motion from Mr. Whiting and seconded by Mr. Miller. The vote was unanimous.**
