Dan Whiting, Chairman, opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m. with Board members, Jarred Miller and Ken Burnett, in attendance.

Public Comment: Mr. Sean Thompson of Aspen Hills was present to voice his dislike for the Township's plan to replace the curbs of his driveway with asphalt when the road is paved. He feels if a driveway is currently concrete that the apron should be replaced with concrete not asphalt. There are currently twelve concrete drives on Aspen Hills/Fair Meadow. Mr. Vince Strahn lives on the cul-de-sac on Fair Meadows. He wants to make sure that if the snowplow tears up the apron on his driveway that the Township will repair it. He noticed that crack seal is shaved off during plow season. Mr. Nick Gorris from the Geauga County Engineer's office stated that a resident's driveway is their driveway. No townships take care of personal driveways. Mr. Thompson just wants what is taken out to be replaced with the same material. He would like the Trustees to get the amount that it would cost to replace those twelve driveway aprons with concrete.
